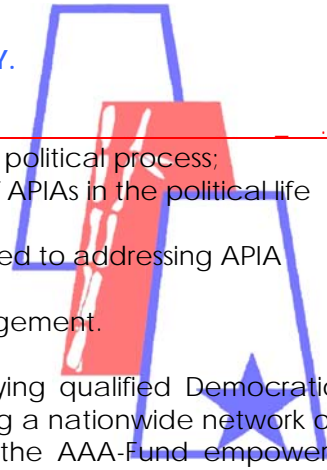

AAA-FUND MISSION

- **Encourage** Asian and Pacific Islander Americans (APIAs) to participate in the political process;
- **Empower** the APIA community to address the severe under-representation of APIAs in the political life of this country;
- **Elect** promising Democratic APIA candidates and other candidates committed to addressing APIA issues at all levels of government; and
- **Educate** the media and general public about APIA issues and political engagement.

Since its start in 2000, the AAA-Fund has pursued these four goals by identifying qualified Democratic candidates, providing them with financial and technical assistance, and building a nationwide network of activists. AAA-Fund members make this possible. Through its membership, the AAA-Fund empowers candidates with the political tools, financial resources, and grassroots assistance they need for victory.

WHAT WE DO

The AAA-Fund endorses candidates who have the commitment, conviction and courage to fight for the APIA community and a better America. It supports candidates at all levels of government by providing financial, technical and grassroots campaign assistance. Since 2000, the national AAA-Fund has endorsed over 60 candidates and raised over \$500,000 for its endorsees. In 2006, three-quarters of the national AAA-Fund's candidates were elected. In 2008, two-thirds of AAA-Fund's 38 endorsed candidates were elected.

OUR RECENT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- 2008:** AAA-Fund launches San Francisco affiliate. DNC approves AAA-Fund Blog as one of two APIA blogs to receive press credentials for the 2008 Democratic Convention. AAA-Fund Los Angeles hosts Presidential Roundtable featuring 1988 Democratic Nominee Michael Dukakis.
- 2007:** AAA-Fund launches Chicago affiliate, starts blog at www.aaa-fund.com, affiliates with the Filipino American Democratic Council, organizes presidential candidate debate in Los Angeles, and conducts monthly online presidential candidate straw polls featuring statements from each of the major Democratic candidates.
- 2006:** AAA-Fund launches Los Angeles and Young Professionals affiliates, and organizes press conference with reporters nationwide to speak with elected officials and scholars about a report on APIA political involvement. Three-quarters of AAA-Fund's 24 endorsed candidates are elected.
- 2005:** AAA-Fund launches Virginia affiliate, and engages APIAs across Virginia to elect Governor Kaine.
- 2004:** AAA-Fund Board members take the lead in organizing a \$1 million fundraiser for US Sen. John Kerry in Washington, DC, help organize APA Gala at the Democratic National Convention, and support local, state and federal candidates all over the country.
- 2003:** AAA-Fund hosts a Presidential Town hall meeting featuring front-runner Gov. Howard Dean that attracts over 500 APIA leaders and every major media organization.

OUR PROJECTS

Elect Democratic Candidates. The AAA-Fund will work closely with the DNC and the Democratic Senatorial and Congressional Campaign Committees to elect US Senator Barack Obama President and to strengthen the Democratic majority in Congress. It will focus its financial and grassroots campaign resources on battleground states and targeted congressional races with swing APA populations.

Launch New Affiliates. The AAA-Fund will continue to add new affiliates across the country with the goal of building a nationwide network of political leaders who give the APIA community voice and power in every corner of the country.

Reach Out to Young Professionals: The AAA-Fund will continue to reach out to young APIA professionals, encourage them to get involved in politics, and identify the APIA political leaders of the future.

Expand the Blog. With official press credentials for the 2008 Democratic National Convention, the AAA-Fund blog will provide the APIA community with an inside view of the 2008 Convention. The blog will also continue to add new writers, seek out diverse views, and broaden its readership.
